#### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY, GENERAL RULES/INFORMATION

- All Exhibitors must provide a completed Horse
  Health Declaration and Waiver prior to riding. All
  exhibitors must pay entry fee to the grounds unless
  they are a Financial Member of the Nanango
  Agricultural, Pastoral & Mining Society.
- The attention of exhibitors is drawn to the fact that entries are accepted subject to the rules of the Qld Chamber of Agricultural Societies and to the Constitution and rules of this society in addition to any special regulations, which appear within this schedule.
- 3. All horses entered in Breed classes MUST be registered with their respective breed societies. 'Any Other Registered Breed' is open to any horse that is registered with a Breed society not represented in the current program, for example, a horse may be registered as a Palomino and a Morgan. It may compete in the Dilute classes and the 'Any Other Registered Breed'. Copies of registration papers must be available to view. Ponies over 12.2hh may be ridden by an adult.
- 4. Horses can only be entered as Hunters or Hacks. They cannot be entered in both. A Hunter should have more substance/bone and is shown in a more subdued turnout such as plain brow bands and no coloured ribbons in the riders' hair. Show hunters are not expected to jump.
- 5. A maiden is a hack or hunter that has never won a first place in a hack or hunter class at an Agricultural Show. A Newcomer hack or hunter has not competed in a ridden class (except racing) prior to 1 July 2023. It must be ridden in a snaffle bit. If the winner of the Newcomer is not eligible for Novice Champion, it may compete for Open Champion. A

- Novice Hack or Hunter has not won an Open Champion at an Agricultural Show or first place at a capital city Royal Show.
- 6. Local classes are limited to riders residing in the postcode area 4615 ONLY. District riders must reside in the South Burnett Regional Council area and the districts of Blackbutt (postcode 4314) and Cooyar (postcode 4402), and must ride a horse that resides for the most part in the same council area.
- 7. Pleasure Hunter or Hack is to be ridden in a snaffle bit with no whip or spurs. A cavesson noseband is permitted but must be loose fitting.
- Stallions may only be ridden and handled by persons
   17 years of age and over.
- 9. No ring will be held up for Competitors in other rings.
- 10. No refunds will be given.
- 11. The Society reserves the right to alter the time or order of any event. ALSO to cancel/reduce or substitute prize money.
- 12. Judges have the right to withhold any prize money where exhibits are deemed to be not of sufficient merit. Judges decision is final. Protest must be lodged in writing to the Secretary together with a \$50 protest fee immediately after the event.
- 13. Stewards have the right to remove any animal from the judging ring if that animal is a danger to the safety of any person or animal. Also to remove any persons that uses inappropriate language towards judges or stewards.
- 14. As per EA/FEI Regulations, sensory whiskers on all exhibits **CANNOT** be removed.
- All riders MUST wear a securely fastened helmet of approved EA Standard at all times whilst mounted.




